

Day one

The "Big Five", bush walks, African skies & spiritual luxury Day one on Safari:


Following your arrival at Mpfuvu Manor we'll head to Umfula Game Reserve (a 45-minute drive) where we'll enjoy a light lunch followed by a late afternoon game walk. You'll watch the sunset over the bush before we gather to enjoy drinks around the campfire. We'll then make our way back to Mpfuvu Manor for the night.

Umfula highlights:

Set along the banks of the Olifants river, Umfula Game Reserve is part of an area that includes the Balule Game Reserve. With a huge variety of fauna and flora, the rolling landscape is home to a number of game species. Hippos, Leopards, and civets are just some of the wildlife that can regularly be spotted at Umfula.







Day two

Umfula to Timbavati

An early alarm call awaits so we can travel to Pridelands Game Reserve for a game walk/drive in our open-sided vehicle. Upon return, we'll tuck into breakfast and prepare for our next stop, Timbavati. A 2-hour drive has us arriving early in the afternoon and after checking in to our overnight accommodation, we head out on a private game drive as the sunsets.


An evening meal and drinks around the campfire round off the day before we hit the hay at Machaton Private Camp. This is the first of two nights here.


Timbavati highlights:

Day three

Machaton Private Camp


Eco-conscious, authentic and oozing spiritual luxury, Machaton is in the heart of the bush meaning your game viewing continues even when you're in bed.

On day four we depart Machaton for Sabi Sands. The drive takes around 2 - 3 hours and we arrive in time for a late afternoon private game drive, an evening meal and drinks around the campfire.
